Mrs. Pui K. Wong devoted her entire life to Christianity. She upheld her faith in Christ the Lord, sharing her love, generosity, and care to those in need.

Mrs. Wong graduated from Guangzhou True Light High School, founded by American Presbyterian and Missionary, Harriet Newell Noyes. She went on to attend the Sun Yat-sen University, obtaining her degree in Education, and becoming a teacher. She began her teaching career at True Light High School, and subsequently taught at Hotung Technical School for Girls, covering subjects such as Chinese History, Chinese Literature, and Geography. Later, she became the Principal of the Kowloon Li Cheng Uk Government Primary School.

As a Christian, she felt it was her calling to help students from poor families. Financially, she helped a few students to complete high school, and even college.

After moving to Hong Kong, she religiously attended the Church of Christ in China – Hop Yat Church Kowloon, worshipping every Sunday until she immigrated to America in 1981.

Candidate must be a **Christian high school senior or continuing college student** of Asian descent associated with the Chinese Presbyterian Church of Oakland, who will be attending college this Fall. Award recipient or a representative must attend the presentation in-person at 890 Fargo Avenue in San Leandro, or via Zoom during the "All Church Family" worship service on **June 21, 2026 from 10:30 am-12:15 pm**. Failure to attend the service will result in forfeiture of your scholarship. One (1) scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a student who serves his/her community, spreads God's love through his/her volunteerism efforts, and sets goals to benefit the Asian American community.

Selection Criteria. Semi-finalists will be selected according to the following criteria:

- Current or past participant of Chinese Presbyterian Church of Oakland
- **A Christian who engages in** active volunteerism to share the love of God with others
- Participation in school, church, and extracurricular activities
- Demonstration of leadership in school, church, and/or community related activities
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Unusual circumstances, if any (i.e. health or financial need)

Timeline for the Scholarship:

- May 3 - Deadline for receiving application and requested materials
- May 17 - Semi-finalists and other candidates notified
- June 7 - Semi-finalists interviewed
- June 14 - Scholarship recipient notified
- June 21 - Awards Presentation at the Chinese Presbyterian Church of Oakland's sister church

- Must be a high school senior starting college in Fall 2026 or a continuing college student in Fall 2026.
- Submit a completed scholarship application form (Word or pdf).
- Submit one (1) letter of recommendation from ***EITHER*** your school or community organization (Word or pdf).
- Submit a 1,000-word (or less) essay
- Submit a copy of your latest transcript and SAT/ACT or other test scores, if applicable
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- All application materials must be received by **May 3, 2026**. Materials arriving after the deadline will not be considered.

NOTE: We ask all recipients to consider "giving back" by volunteering at the Chinese Presbyterian Church of Oakland or donating to this fund AFTER you graduate from college, to help perpetuate this scholarship in the future.
