for Girls, covering subjects such as Chinese History, Chinese Literature, and Geography. Later, she became the Principal of the Kowloon Li Cheng Uk Government Primary School.

As a Christian, she felt it was her calling to help students from poor families. Financially, she helped a few students to complete high school, and even college.
